Mijares Angoitia and Ritch Mueller return for toll road loan in Mexico

Mexican toll road operator Red de Carreteras de Occidente (RCO) has hired Mijares, Angoitia, Cortés y Fuentes SC to obtain a loan worth 2 billion Mexican pesos (US\$105 million).

Ritch, Mueller, Heather y Nicolau, SC advised the lender Banco Santander. The deal closed on 5 July.

RCO, which operates five motorways in the central and western parts of Mexico, will use the money for general capital expenditure.

Mijares Angoitia, which has advised RCO several times before, helped the company restructure debt in December 2018. RCO repurchased previously issued debt through a tender offer for 1.5 billion pesos (US\$85 million). It also issued new debt worth 8.3 billion pesos (US\$435 million) under a 20-billion-peso (US\$1 billion) bond programme.

Ritch Mueller has advised on credit lines to RCO in the past too.
